# Course Leveling

- For tenth grade history, there are THREE levels.
  - College Prep
  - Advanced College Prep
  - Honors
  - This course is College Prep
  - Most of you will continue on to College Prep next year.
  - Some of you may move up to Advanced College Prep.

# How do you know which level you should take next year?

There are <u>official history department guidelines</u> that you, your parents, and Ms. Bal will consider when deciding which level you should take next year.

### Guidelines for moving UP a level...

Teachers will recommend that a student change from College Prep to Advanced College Prep when (s)he meets all of the following criteria:

- ✓ The student has a significant number of "A" grades on major tests, papers, and/or projects.
- ✓ The student completes writing and research assignments comfortably, exceeding the class standard without need for additional guidance or re-writing.
- ✓ The student reads in-class and homework assignments easily, understanding both content and concepts.
- ✓ The student understands questions and concepts in class discussion quickly and easily.
