The Qur'an's Commandments

Directions: Below is a list of nine translations from the Qur'an. For each, rewrite the quote as a commandment for Muslims to follow that begins with, "A Muslim must..." or "A Muslim must not..." Note: The numbers in parentheses refer to the chapter and verse cited from the Qur'an.

"Thy Lord hath decreed that ye worship none but Him" (17:23)

A Muslim must not worship anything but God.

- 1. "And the Lord hath decreed that ye be kind to your parents...and say 'My Lord bestow on them Thy mercy even as they cherished me in childhood." (17:23-24)
- 2. "Take not life which God has made sacred except for just cause." (17:33)
- 3. "Nor come night o adultery: for it is a shameful deed." [adultery = cheating on your husband/wife]" (17:32)
- 4. "And dispute ye not with the People of the Book (Christians and Jews) ... unless it be with those of them who inflict wrong (and injury): but say "We believe in the Revelation which has come down to us and in that which came down to you; Our God and your God is one; and it is to Him we bow." (29:46)

5. "Those who slander chaste women are cursed in this life and in the Hereafter." [slander = lie about; chaste = virgin] (24:23-24)

6. "If any do turn his back to them [an attacker] on such a day [of battle] unless it be in a strategy of war, or to retreat a troop [of his own], he draws on himself the wrath of God." (8:16)
7. "Do you see what happens to one who denies God? He shares the same fate as one who refuses the orphan and does not help to feed the indigent [the poor]." (107:1-3)
8. "Satan's plan is to excite enmity and hatred between humans, with intoxicants and gambling, and hurt your remembrance of God and prayer. Will you not then abstain [not do those things]?" (5:91).
9. "Make peace between them with justice, and be fair." (99:9)
